- (d) Work will be allocated in accordance with clause C.1.6.1 of the tender conditions being: The Employer intends to appoint one tenderer (the highest ranked tenderer ("the winner") and in addition a Standby tenderer) for the Allocation of work on a "winner-takes-all" basis in terms of the definitions.
