

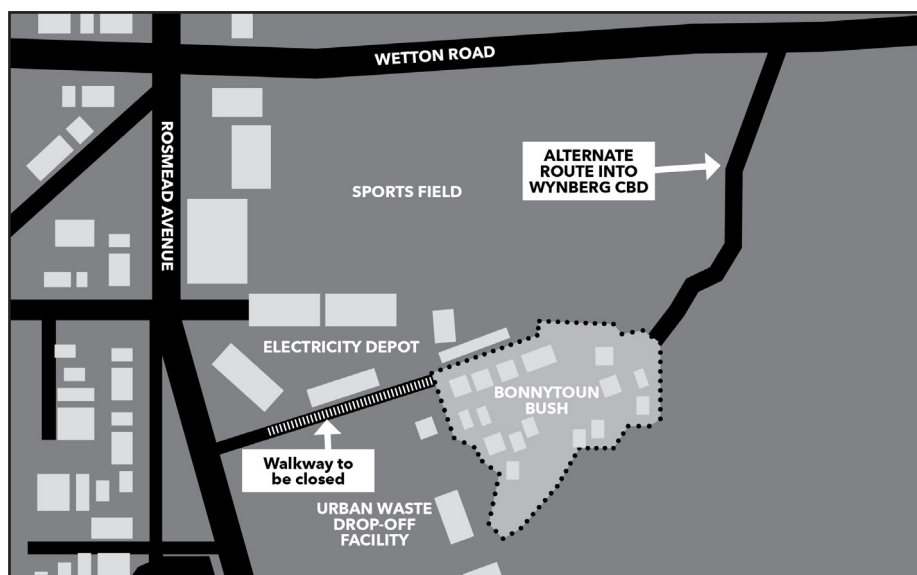


HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED CLOSURE OF THE PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY INTO AND OUT OF BONNYTOWN BUSH INFORMAL SETTLEMENT, WYNBERG EAST

The City of Cape Town intends to permanently close the pedestrian walkway leading to the Bonnytown Bush informal settlement, as indicated on the map below.

Reasons for proposing the permanent closure:

- The Wynberg community experiences daily losses such as cable theft, home burglaries, theft out of motor vehicles and the robbery of personal belongings while on foot.
- Perpetrators escape through the lane into the informal settlement, since it is a convenient escape into and out of the informal settlement.



In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups may submit comments, recommendations or input to the municipality from Wednesday 26 March to Wednesday 30 April 2025.
