## **INFORMATION STATEMENT**

### **PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE CONTRACT FOR TENDER NUMBER: 072Q/2025/26 - UPGRADE OF VOORTREKKER ROAD, FROM 4TH AVENUE TO 12TH AVENUE, MAITLAND FOR THE PERIOD FROM THE DATE OF COMMENCEMENT FOR THE PERIOD OF 42 MONTHS.**

In terms of section 33(1)(a)(i)(aa) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003, read in conjunction with section 21A of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 the following Information Statement is hereby made public summarising the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Municipality's (the City) obligations in respect of a contract(s) the City intends entering into. The contract(s) will impose financial obligations on the City for a period longer than three (3) financial years. The financial impact will be for a period of four (4) financial years: FY2026/2027, FY2027/2028, FY2028/2029 and FY2029/2030.

Following a procurement or other relevant approval process, the City of Cape Town (the City) intends to conclude a long-term contract for Upgrade of Voortrekker Road, from 4th Avenue to 12th Avenue, Maitland.

**Comment is therefore sought in respect of the draft long-term contract i.e. beyond three (3) financial years.**

Summary of the City's contractual obligations:

- Appointment of a Construction contractor to carry out construction services subject to the conditions of contract.
- Financial obligations have an estimated value in the amount of R 220 073 075.81 (inclusive of VAT).
