The City's Urban Mobility Directorate is calling on members of the public and interested parties to submit comments on the proposal to upgrade and construct non-motorised transport (NMT) infrastructure in Brackenfell, Kraaifontein, Wallacedene and Bloekombos. The statutory public commenting process is an important aspect of this undertaking. Although it is the City's intention to implement calming measures at all the sites listed via link below, there are cost-related variables which are still unknown at this point. Implementation will therefore be subject to availability of funding.
