



HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED TEMPORARY SUBWAY CLOSURES IN WYNBERG AND SOUTHFIELD

The City's Urban Mobility Directorate is calling on residents and road users in the Wynberg and Southfield area to submit comments on its proposal to implement the temporary closure of the subways listed below:

- 1) Piers Road subway - Wynberg
- 2) York Road subway - Wynberg
- 3) Tiverton Road subway - Wynberg
- 4) Naruna Crescent subway - Southfield

The reasons for proposing the temporary closures are:

- Illegal use of the subways
- Vandalism of infrastructure / pumps, electrical supply, lighting
- Improved pedestrian safety
- Illegal occupants
- Unsafe conditions - robberies
- Nearby alternative routes

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input on the proposed temporary subway closures to the municipality from 3 November until 4 December 2025.
